As in previous years, the Minisymposium will be collocated with the Austrian Particle Forum (March 31<sup>st</sup> 2016, see separate invitation). The organizers are looking forward to meeting you in Graz!

## Submission of Papers

The submission of papers and posters will be handled via a webpage (see „Registration and Information“ on [www.chemical-engineering.at](http://www.chemical-engineering.at) for details). Please use the template provided on the webpage.

The authors shall carefully review their contributions prior to submission, since a detailed proof reading by the organizers will not be possible. The organizers reserve the right to reject contributions that do not fit the scope of the Minisymposium, or that are of low quality.

For oral presentations, the authors are expected to present a 20 minute talk. For posters, the authors are expected to attend the poster session, as well as to provide a short talk (max. 3 minutes) to introduce the poster to the audience. For all talks, PowerPoint or PDF is the preferred presentation format.

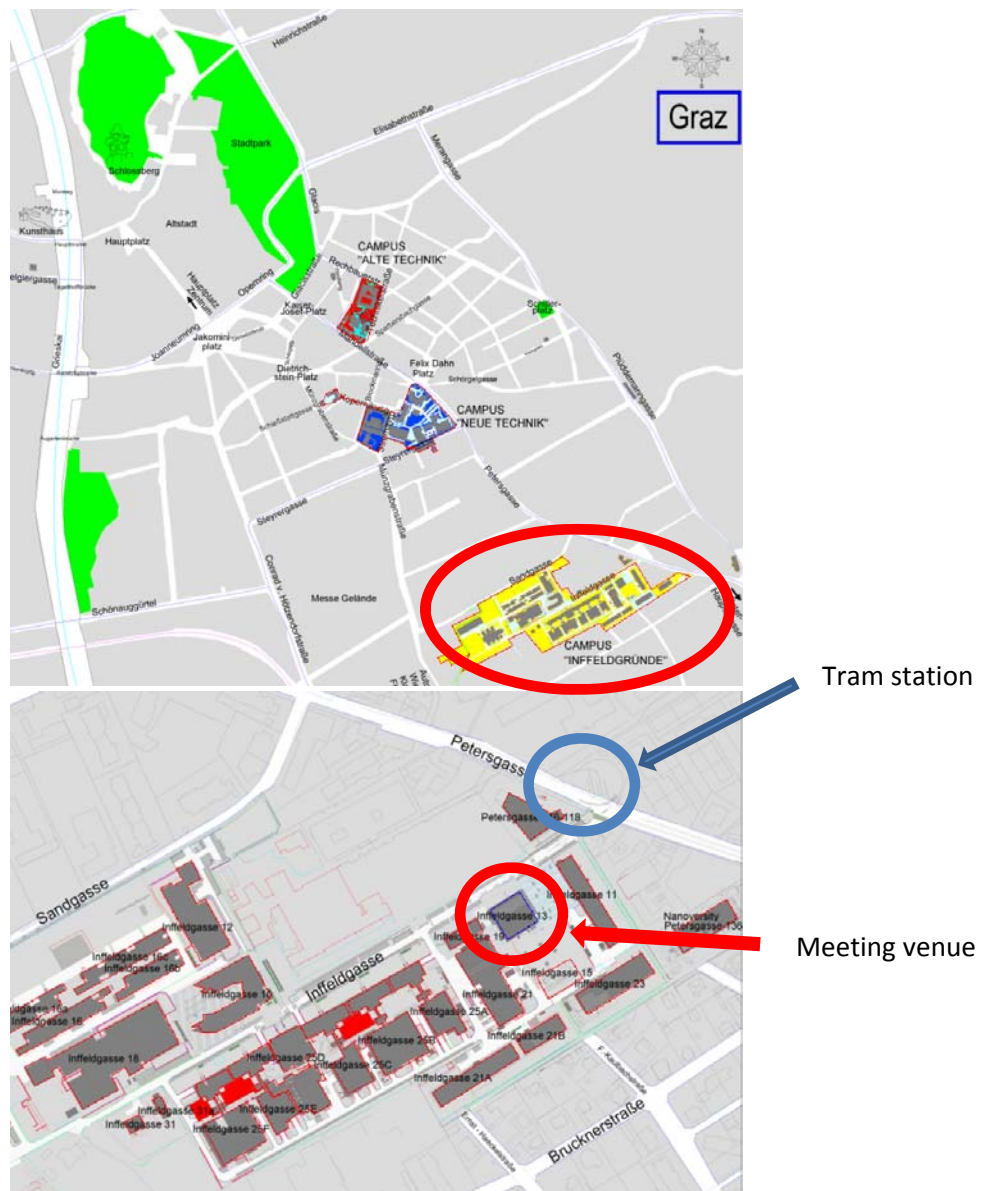
